



POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT
Mental Health Practitioner
Guild South
4:00 PM—Midnight Shift

Purpose:

This position is responsible to provide supportive services to residents through building individuals' strengths, directing efforts to assist people managing their mental health, assisting with stabilizing acute and crisis situations and assisting with skill building towards increased independence. This position supports and provides services to all residential programs.

Desired Education and Experience:

- Holds a Bachelor's degree in one of the behavioral sciences or related fields from an accredited college or university and has at least 2,000 hours of supervised experience in the delivery of services to persons with mental illness, or
- Has at least 6,000 hours of supervised experience in the delivery of services to persons with mental illness.

Other Requirements:

- Must be ambulatory and able to negotiate stairways.
- Must be able to lift and carry heavy weights that could be up to or even exceed 40 pounds.
- Must not be actively receiving services from Guild Incorporated and must not have received services within the last two years.

Key Responsibilities:

- Support residents in acquiring the skills needed to live in the community so they can lead independent, self-directed lives.
- Support residents in gaining an understanding of their illness so that they are better able to achieve their life goals.
- Provide consistent program plan follow-up to help residents attain their goals.
- Educate residents to independently, and safely, manage their medications in preparation for living in the community.
- Ensure personal safety and a safe environment for residents to promote health, well-being and independence.
- Orient residents upon move-in so that a hospitable transition to Guild South program and services is assured.
- Maintain and utilize resident files to clearly document resident progress at Guild South and to ensure that licensing requirements are met.
- Maintain continuity and coordination of services to residents.
